





# Self-Service DNS Management Access Guide

- 1) In your web browser, navigate to [dns.mcnc.org](https://dns.mcnc.org). You will be redirected to an MCNC login page, where you will enter your username and click 'next'.





This is what an Okta push notification looks like. Assuming you're the one who initiated the login attempt, click 'Yes It's Me'.


3) You should now be redirected to the DNS entries for your organization:
