- 1) While creating your account, select 'Set up' under the Okta Verify heading. You will see a QR code that you will use to enroll your phone with the Okta Verify app.

Set up Okta Verify

1. On your other device, download the Okta Verify app from the App Store® (iPhone® and iPad®) or on Google Play (Android® devices).
2. Open the app and follow the instructions to add your account
3. When prompted, tap **Scan a QR code**, then scan the QR code below:






2) Download the Okta Verify app from your device's app store.




3) Open Okta Verify and click 'Add Account', then select 'Organization' for account type.




4) When you see 'Add Account from Another Device', click 'Skip'.



5) Click 'Yes, Ready to Scan' and use your device's camera to view the QR code.



- 6) For additional security, you can require Face ID or your device passcode to log into Okta on your device (this is optional).



- 7) When you log into your account the first time, enter your username and click 'Next'. You will then be prompted to select a verification method from the ones you have configured.
